#### **Entry Requirements**

- i. A Bachelor's Degree Education in Early Childhood (Hons) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50;
   OR
- ii. A Bachelor's Degree (Hons) in relevant field with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as accepted by the University's Senate AND must have three (3) years working experience in Early Childhood field;
- iii. A Bachelor's Degree (Hons) with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as accepted by University's Senate AND Diploma in Early Childhood Education / must have four (4) years working experience in Early Childhood Education fields;
   OR
- iv. A Bachelor's Degree in Education with CGPA below 2.50 can be accepted subject to five (5) years working experience in Early Childhood Education and rigorous internal assessment; OR
- v. A Bachelor's Degree in the field or related fields or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting a CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment;

Candidates without a qualification in the related fields or working experience in the relevant fields must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the HEP and meet the minimum CGPA based on (i) to (v).

- vi. Entry requirements for admission into the Master's programme (Level 7, MQF) through APEL A as approved by the Ministry of Education (MOHE). Applicants must be / have:
  - 1. A Malaysian citizen; AND
  - 2. The candidate should be more than 30 years of age in the year of application;
  - 3. Possess at least STPM / Diploma / A-Levels / equivalent qualifications;
